Our church nursery is in Shelton Hall Room 3. Children ages 0-4 will be cared for and supervised by our Childcare Staff.

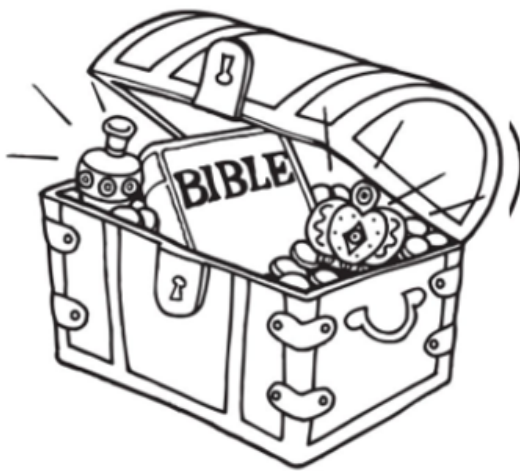
### **CHILDREN’S CHAPEL**

**The Brotherhood of St. Andrew.**

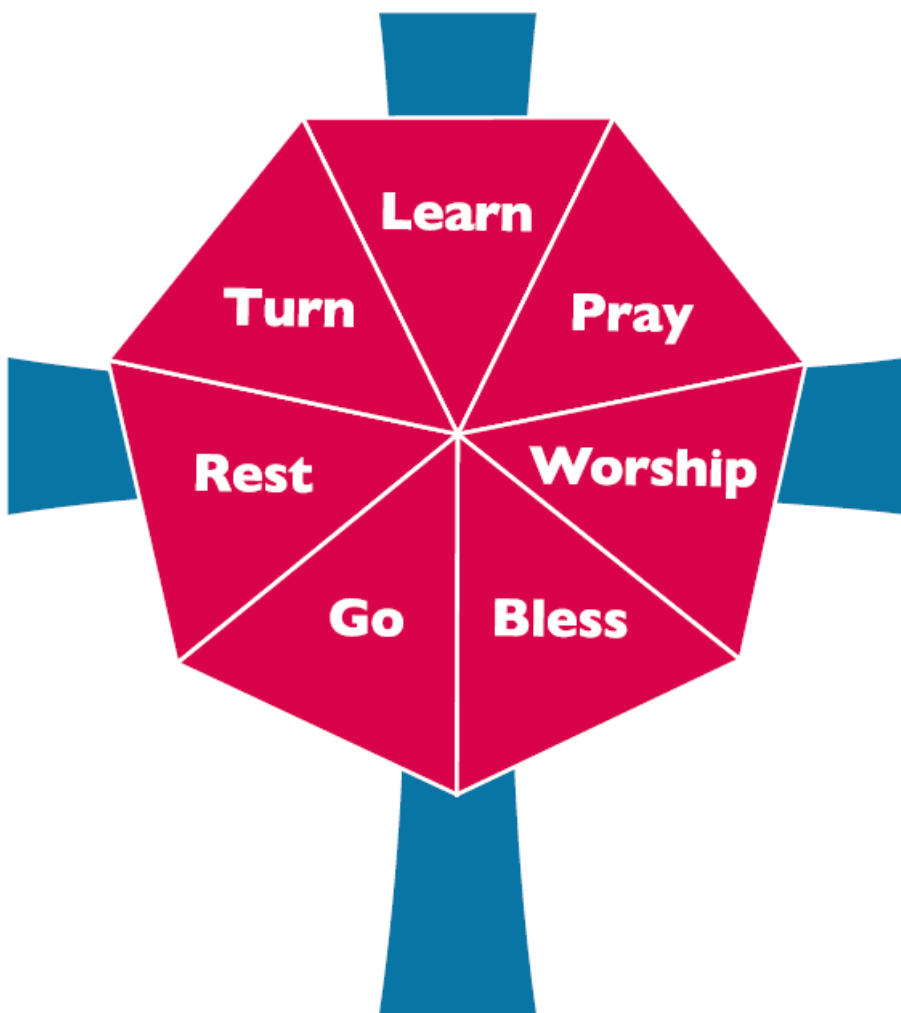

**LEARN** Reflect on Scripture each day, especially Jesus' life and teachings

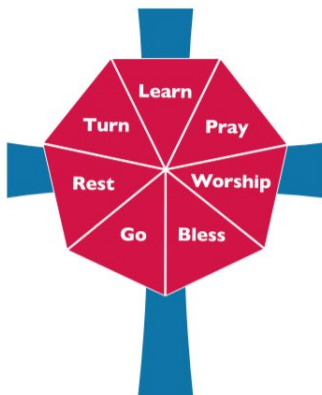
**PRAY** Dwell intentionally with God each day
