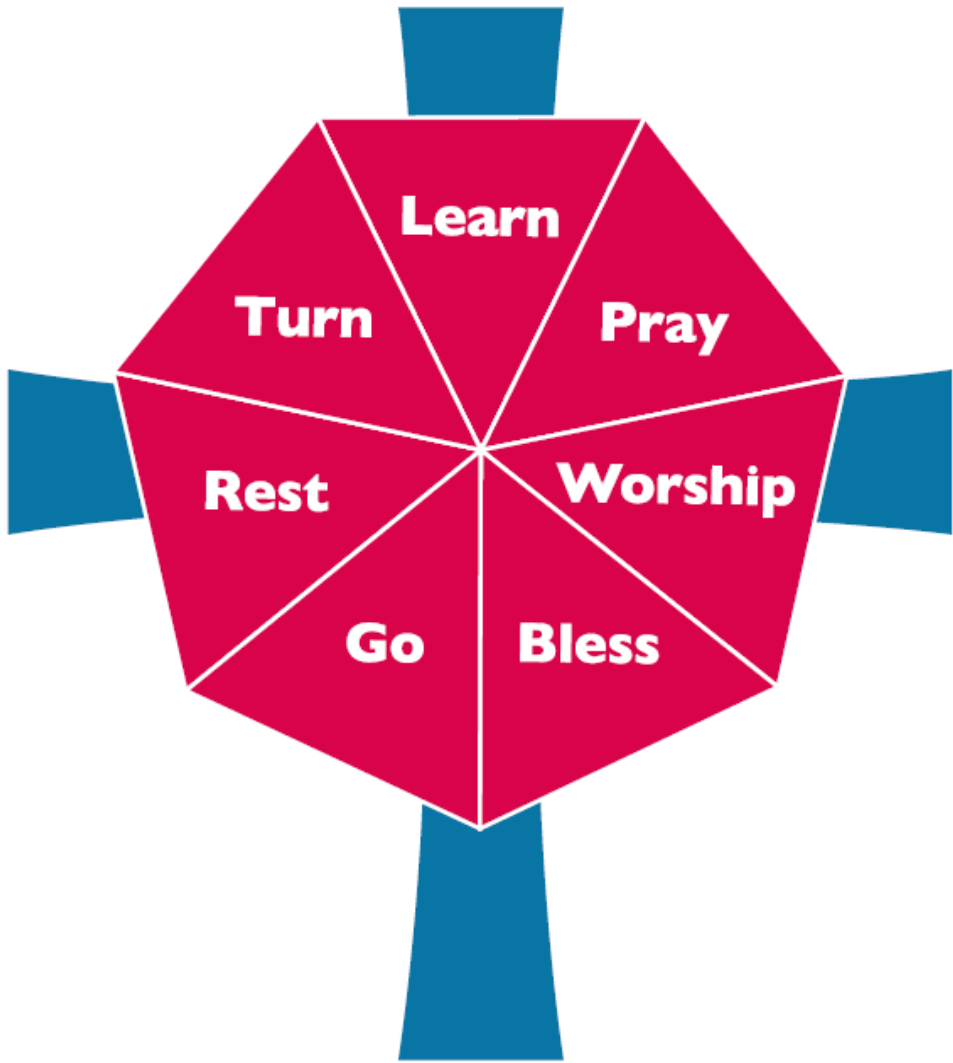
1. What were the two sisters names?
