Upcoming Fall 2019 Diocesan Retreats

Mother/Daughter Retreat at Camp Capers (Sept. 13 - 15), led by the Rev. Shanna Neff, invites mothers (or mother figures) to a weekend retreat with their daughters (ages 6 - 18) that is filled with fun activities, Bible study, worship, and authentic conversations about nurturing this special relationship.

The cost is \$150 per adult and \$110 per child. Visit dwtx.org/capers to sign up.



The Spiritual Retreat in Recovery hosted at Mustang Island Conference Center (October 4 - 6), led by the Rev. Philip May, will explore the theory of family systems, how these connections can help us understand the sources of addiction, and provide new tools to change patterns of the past and find healing.

Through this retreat, the diocesan Recovery Ministry seeks to provide a safe place to deepen one's spiritual journey to anyone recovering from alcoholism, or other addictions, and to families or friends affected by this disease.

The cost is \$195 per person, with a \$75 commuter rate. Online registration will open August 28th; visit dwtx.org/events to sign up.

Art and Soul Retreat at Camp Capers (October 11 - 13) will focus on feeding the soul through art! Together, create a space for creativity and for spiritual formation in community with other artists from across the diocese.
